Infant Development Programme provides supports to children from birth to age 3 through in-home visits, weekly playgroup sessions, developmental assessments, lending library and information and referrals to relevant community resources.

Supported Child Development Programme enables children birth to 19 years who require extra support, to successfully participate in inclusive licensed neighbourhood preschools, daycares and after school centres.

Aboriginal Infant and Supported Child Development Programme offers culturally sensitive and family centered support for Aboriginal children birth to 19 years who require extra support. Support can be provided to families in-home, preschool or childcare setting, along with drop-in Playgroup sessions and Aboriginal Family Nights.

Variety Junction Preschool provides an inclusive preschool setting licensed to serve up to 20 children between the ages of 3 and 5 years.

Child and Youth Programme offers school aged children who require extra support, the opportunity to participate in social and recreational programmes that are relaxing, safe and creative.
